4 **WHEREAS,** the Youth of the Tohono O'Odham Nation reorganized the Youth
5 Council to be known as the Tohono O'Odham Nation Youth Council
6 and to serve as the official voice for the Youth of the Tohono
7 O'Odham Nation; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Youth of the Tohono O'Odham Nation have recognized the need
11 for additional organized recreational and educational projects within
12 communities and districts; and

14 **WHEREAS,** such projects will focus on cultural awareness, educational
15 advancement, self-esteem, social and personal development. To also
16 advance communication among the Youth of the Nation; and

19 **WHEREAS,** Tohono O'Odham Youth Services, a tribal supported program, fully
20 endorses and supports the initiative of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
21 Youth Council and will assist the Youth Council in addressing and
22 coordinating such project; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation Youth Council will consist of (2)
26 representatives and (2) alternates from each of the eleven (11)
27 districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation Youth Council will be obligated to**

5 **make an annual report to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**

7 **and or upon request from the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**

9 **and or the Tohono O'Odham Youth Services.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
11 **Council that it does support, recognize, and authorize the**

13 **establishment of the Tohono O'Odham Nation Youth Council as the**

15 **official voice of the Youth of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the**

18 **Tohono O'Odham Nation Youth Council will remain under the**
19
20 **direct supervision of the Tohono O'Odham Youth Services Program,**
21
22 **providing support for the Youth initiatives.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**
24 **on the 5TH day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present**
25 **with a vote of 1,639.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 124.0 [07]**
26 **ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of**
27 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






