3 **WHEREAS,** the members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation have for many years  
4  
5 been desirous of continuing their education and training to promote  
6  
7 their well being and to support themselves and their families; and

8 **WHEREAS,** tribal members who have ventured into the field of continuing  
9  
10 education and requested for financial support have often found it  
11  
12 to be a long and frustrating process; and

13 **WHEREAS,** funding for education is fragmented and very often inadequate; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation is concerned for its members and their  
15  
16 efforts to better themselves; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Nation does have adequate financial resources available through  
18  
19 its gaming revenues.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nation hereby establishes the  
21  
22 Tohono O'Odham Nation Scholarship Fund (TONSF), which will be  
23  
24 utilized to ensure full scholarship funding for tribal members who  
25  
26 wish to further their education and develop their skills.

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does

**Proposed Budget dated May 1, 1995 as stating the Council's intent and purpose to provide educational financial support to tribal members.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation does allocate Six Million, One Hundred and Fifty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Dollars (\$6,155,800.) from its gaming revenue for the Tohono O'Odham Nation Scholarship Fund.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Branch of the Nation, through its Education Department, accepts the Tohono O'Odham Nation Scholarship Fund Narrative and Proposed Budget which will be utilized as a base for the development of the administrative and operational program for scholarship assistance.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation Scholarship Fund be reviewed for its effectiveness during the initial funding year and that a report be submitted to the Legislative Council, to include recommendations and budget analysis**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 989.5 FOR; 333.5 AGAINST; 188.0 NOT VOTING; and 252.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) & (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
