8 **proposed FY 1997 Bureau of Indian Affairs Budget Formulation**  
9 **Process; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tribes were requested to name their top five priorities for**  
11  
12 **Bureau of Indian Affairs funding, on May 2, 1995, however, Tribes**  
13  
14 **agreed to re-convene on May 15, 1995 at which time they will**  
15 **decide on the top five priorities upon consultation with their Tribes;**

18 **WHEREAS, the top five priorities will be part of the Phoenix Area testimony**  
19  
20 **to the Assistant Secretary and the Deputy Commissioner for the**  
21  
22 **Bureau of Indian Affairs during the National Budget Hearings**  
23 **scheduled for May 22-24, 1995 in Washington DC; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation currently receives funding from the**

26 **Bureau of Indian Affairs through 638 contracts.**
