15 O'odham Nation has provided tribal citizens, especially those living
16 in areas where activities are proposed or ongoing, with adequate
17 information concerning the amount of funds available for proposed
18 community development and housing activities, the range of
19 activities that may be assisted, and other important program
20 requirements, and solicited their views and participation; and

25 **WHEREAS,** the traditional Tribal means of citizen involvement were followed
26 through District Council meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative
27 Council meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs,



The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 08TH, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,627.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 136.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) 3 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


