

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Certification of Selection Criteria utilized by the Districts for Selection of  
HUD-ICDBG Renovations)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-231**

**WHEREAS,** the Department of Housing and Urban Development guidelines require a selection criteria for identifying those families most in need of housing who will receive housing renovations and electrical project through the 1995 HUD ICDBG grant program; and

**WHEREAS,** the Districts participating in the 1995 ICDBG grants program (of the 11 Districts which comprise the Tohono O'odham Nation) defined their selection criteria on the basis of families with elderly or handicapped member; families who lived in seriously overcrowded conditions; families living in a structurally unstable home or a home in need or urgent repairs; or a home with no amenities (i.e. indoor plumbing, sewage, water or electrification lines); families with very low income not to exceed 90% of the median income for the area adjusted for family size; and

**WHEREAS,** District Councils consulted with their own Housing Committees and reviewed the applicant list of the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority; and



**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Planning and Operations Department undertook a cost estimate for each of the proposed building renovations and that the estimate conformed to standards of the National Association of Real Estate Appraisers.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that the proposed selected participants and projects for the HUD ICDBG grant be therefore adopted for submission to HUD for funding.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 08TH, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,627.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 136.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c) 2 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
