**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Behavioral Health Services - Alcoholism and Rehabilitation and Aftercare Program for Adolescents and Community Based Prevention Training Components under FY 1995 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Public Health, Indian Health Services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to renew for provision of services during FY 1996; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approves the FY 1996 Division of Alcoholism - Alcoholism/Rehabilitation and Aftercare Program for Adolescents - Community Based Prevention Training program components renewal proposal and budgets.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Services to renew with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for provision of services titled: Division of Alcoholism - Alcoholism/Rehabilitation and Aftercare**

**Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in  
the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no  
executed contract has been awarded by the Indian Health Service,  
unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs consistent  
with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the

**Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any  
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for  
further prior approval by this Council.**




