**RESOLUTION NO. 95-249**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Readiness Employment Assistance Program (REAP) under FY 1995 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to renew for the REAP initiatives during Fiscal Year 1996; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the Fiscal Year 1996 Readiness Employment Assistance Program renewal proposal and budget.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to renew with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638, as amended, for provision of services titled: Readiness Employment Assistance Program**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the duration of this renewal shall commence  
on **October 01, 1995** through **September 30, 1996**.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in  
the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no  
executed contract has been approved by the Bureau of Indian  
Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs  
consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the  
Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any  
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for  
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
on the 18TH day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present  
with a vote of 1,504.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 259.0 [10]  
ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article






