

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1996 Food Distribution and Family Nutrition Program Proposal)**

3 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated successfully a program
4
5 whereby the diet and nutritional needs of eligible Tohono O'Odham
6
7 have been served by supplementing other federal social service
8
9 program; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the funding for the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution/Family
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12 Nutrition Services has been provided through the United States
13
14 Department of Agriculture; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the continued operation of the Food Distribution Program is
16
17 essential to provide basic diet and nutrition for eligible clients; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution and Family Nutrition

20 Program has submitted a budget for Fiscal Year 1996 for review
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22 and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative

25 Council that it hereby approves the proposal for funding of the

27 Tohono O'Odham Food Distribution and Family Nutrition Program

from the United States Department of Agriculture.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be from
October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in
the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no
executed grant has been awarded by the United States Department
of Agriculture, unless approved by mutual agreement of both
contracting parties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the
Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
on the 18TH day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
with a vote of 1,504.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 259.0 [10]
ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article

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VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



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


