RESOLUTION NO. 95-255

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Law
Enforcement and Detention Services/Anti-Drug Program under FY
93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to renew for provision of
services during FY 1996; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved
the FY 1996 Law Enforcement and Detention Services/Anti-Drug
Program renewal proposal and budgets.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian
Affairs to renew with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638
as amended for the provision of services titled: Law Enforcement
and Detention Services.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this renewal shall commence on
October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in
the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no
executed contract has been approved by the Bureau of Indian
Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs
consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
the contract provided however, that any amendments affecting the
funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for
further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
the 18TH, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
a vote of 1,511.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [252.0] 10
ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article
VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
