of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation was informed by the Acting Superintendent of Education  
of the Drug Free School monies for Drug Awareness activities; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the  
contract shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono  
O'odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval by the  
Johnson O'Malley Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council does hereby approve the amendment to the Johnson  
O'Malley Program contract to incorporate the Drug Free School  
monies and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached  
budget.**

**Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
**Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
