

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 96 Higher Education Program Renewal Proposal)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-259**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Higher Education Program under FY 1995 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to renew for provision of services during FY 1996; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1996 Higher Education Program renewal proposal and budget.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to renew with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638, as amended, for the provision of services titled: Higher Education.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this renewal shall commence on October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed contract has been approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 18TH, day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,639.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 124.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




