

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 96 Employment Assistance Program Renewal Proposal)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-260**

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Employment Assistance Program under FY 1995 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

**WHEREAS,** such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to renew for provision of services during FY 1996; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1996 Employment Assistance Program renewal proposal and budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to renew with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638, as amended, for the provision of services titled: Employment Assistance.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the duration of this renewal shall commence on October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

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3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the  
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5 **Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in**  
6 **the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no**  
7 **executed contract has been approved by the Bureau of Indian**  
8 **Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs**  
9 **consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.**

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11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the  
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13 **Tohono Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated**  
14 **official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract**  
15 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or**  
16 **funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior**  
17 **approval by this Council.**

23 **on the 18TH day of MAY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present**  
24 **with a vote of 1,639.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 124.0 [08]**  
25 **ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article**  
26 **VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
28 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
**Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


