

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1996 Credit & Finance Renewal Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-266

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Credit and Finance Program under FY 1995 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to renew for provision of services during FY 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1996 Credit & Finance Program renewal proposal and budget.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to renew with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 as amended for the provision of services titled: Credit and Finance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this renewal shall commence on October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

9 executed contract has been approved by the Bureau of Indian

11 Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award costs

13 consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

16 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any
17
18 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute

20 the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
21
22 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for
23
24 further prior approval by this Council.

25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
26 the 18TH, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
27 a vote of 1,349.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [414.0] 10
28 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article
VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
