

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1995 WIC Program Supplement Budget Modification #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-275**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for women, infants and children through the WIC/ITCA budget and Nation's supplement resolution 94-436; and**

**WHEREAS, the purchase of a computer and printer and accessories are needed to improve the quality of services provided to WIC clients and to cover over expenditures in the telephone line item.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nation's WIC Supplement Budget Modification No. 1 has been reviewed and approved by appropriate Legislative Committees and Legislative Council to purchase a computer, printer and accessories and to cover telephone line item over expenditure with no changes in the base budget amount.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council the 19TH, day of May, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,459.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [304.0] 09 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)3 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
