

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Budget Modification for EPA Lead [Pb] Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-321**

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3 **WHEREAS,** in June of 1994, Resolution No. 94-158 of the Legislative Council  
4  
5 approved the submission of a grant application to the EPA to fund  
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7 a training, education, and information-gathering program aimed at  
8  
9 determining whether there is a lead contamination problem on the  
10  
11 Nation; and

12 **WHEREAS,** there were errors in the line item breakdown of the original  
13  
14 budget approved by the Legislative Council which need to be  
15  
16 corrected; and

17 **WHEREAS,** it has been determined by the Planning and Operations Department  
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19 that the tasks of the Lead Program Specialist should require one  
20  
21 job position instead of two; and

22 **WHEREAS** there have been delays in the tasks necessary to fulfill the  
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24 assistance agreement between the Tohono O'Odham Nation and the  
25  
26 United States Environmental Protection Agency; and

27 **WHEREAS,** these delays have created the need for amendment to the assistance  
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29 agreement to extend the grant agreement for six months (from  
30  
31 7/01/94 - 7/14/95 to 7/01/94 -1/14/96).

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby approves the attached budget modification for the Lead Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Legislative Council approves an amendments to the assistance agreement between the Tohono O'Odham Nation and the United States Environmental Protection Agency to extend the budget and project period 6 months.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 6TH day of JUNE, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 994.0 FOR; 451.0 AGAINST; 431.0 NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
