

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Authorizing Indian Health Service to Continue Inventory and
Assessment Survey on Dumpsites)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 95-338

WHEREAS, on July 05, 1995 a Special Session was held to address the Indian Health Service Protocol on Dumpsites; and

WHEREAS, among further discussion pertaining to the dumpsites on the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Indian Health Service requested that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council give approval to conduct an Inventory and Assessment Survey on the dumpsites in order to complete the work already in progress; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has determined that the Inventory and Assessment Study on dumpsites be completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the Inventory and Assessment Study to be conducted and completed by the Indian Health Service.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day of JULY, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 (7) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section li(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
