WHEREAS, there has been a significant increase in attorney time and expense associated with protecting the Nation's interests in the bankruptcy proceeding involving the Central Arizona Irrigation & Drainage District, the related negotiations concerning a restructuring of the Central Arizona Project ("CAP"), and the lawsuit recently filed by the Central Arizona Water Conservation District against the United States affecting the availability of CAP water to satisfy the Nation's water claims; and

WHEREAS, the additional sum of \$40,000., is required for legal fees and
