RESOLUTION NO. 95-394

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation, was apprised
of the recent action of the United States Senate on the FY 1996
Interior Appropriations; and**

**WHEREAS, the Senate reductions of 32% to tribal priority allocations for
Tohono O'odham is estimated at 1.9 million for FY 1996; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's programs and departments received
federal funding (638 Contracts) will be drastically effected, and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, along with other tribes strongly
believes that the trust responsibilities that the United States
Government through Treaties and Executive Orders are being
neglected.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation is
strongly opposed to the recent actions by the United States Senate
on the FY 1996 Interior Appropriations reductions; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the trust responsibilities through Treaties and
Executive Orders are being neglected by the Unites States of
America to the Tohono O'odham Nation and all Indian Tribes; and**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 11TH day of AUGUST, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
