LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 95-427

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did discuss at length concerns regarding the FY96 Budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance's responsibilities is to review, modify and approve budgets for the programs; and

WHEREAS, a directive from the Executive Branch was given to the programs of a deadline date to stop all purchase orders or expenditures; and

WHEREAS, some programs need to modify their budget and establish their FY96 Budgets and have them finalized for approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Budget & Finance Committee be restricted from any travel until all FY96 Budgets and/or Modifications have been reviewed and approved for the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Special Session scheduled for September 25, 1995.
