Pinal County)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-428

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (Department)
provides Law Enforcement services to the Tohono O'odham Nation
(Nation) including Florence Village in Pinal County; and

WHEREAS, the Department has limited resources and manpower to adequately
respond to calls from Florence Village because of the distance
between the Department's headquarters and Florence Village; and

WHEREAS, Florence Village residents have expressed the need to have Law
Enforcement services capable of readily responding to calls from
Florence Village; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 1995 the Nation's Chief of Police did meet with
Pinal County officials to begin a dialogue on providing Law
Enforcement services to Florence Village; and

WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District, by resolution, did approve the Mutual
Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal County on
August 19, 1995, a copy of which is attached; and

WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the Agreement and recommends approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal County is approved in the form attached hereto.**
- 2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Nation.**
- 3. Any proposed termination of the Agreement initiated by the Nation or modification of the Agreement shall require the prior approval of the Legislative Council.**


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 13TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,742.0 FOR; 134.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II and Article VI Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
