Executive, and any Districts with Farms".


The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on

present with a vote of 1,629.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 105.0 NOT VOTING; and 142.0
[08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(b) of
Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
