

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization to Continue Law Enforcement Services)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95- 459

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation's fiscal year for FY-95 ends on
September 30, 1995; and**

**WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement program in January of 1995 received
authorization to carry over special appropriation funds in the
amount of \$1,607,627 for FY-95; and**

**WHEREAS, it is the Tohono O'Odham Nation's desire not to interrupt the
special appropriations funding for the Law Enforcement Program;
and**

**WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Law Enforcement program to carry over all
unexpended FY-95 funds into FY-96 as several positions remained
unfilled, which left the three proposed substations without buildings
or equipment.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby
authorizes the Law Enforcement Program to continue operations at
current spending levels in order that services will not be
interrupted.**

14 08 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of
15 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
16 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting
17 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


