

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization to Continue San Xavier District Government Operations)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-474**

**WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Administration is unable to forward its FY '96 approved budget to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (TOLC) before the legislature concludes its last regular session of FY '95; and**

**WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the San Xavier District to continue its fiscal operation pending the review and approval of its FY '96 budget by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, the District has sufficient funds in its treasury to cover all expenditures during the interim period.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it does hereby authorize the San Xavier District to continue operation pending the review of its approved FY '96 Budget.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 27TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,375.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 501.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II and Article VI Section 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
