**WHEREAS, the 1995 fiscal year funding levels for the Executive Branch will
end on September 30, 1995; and**

**WHEREAS, the continued operations of the programs and departments of the
Executive Branch of the Tohono O'odham Nation requires adoption
of an operating budget, the granting of spending authority, and the
appropriation of funds for the 1996 fiscal year; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive Branch of the Nation has prepared and presented a
budget that reflects the same spending levels as Fiscal Year 1995
with the exception of a 4% Cost of Living Adjustment for salaries,
and this budget is attached hereto and incorporated by reference;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation has reviewed
these budgets and recommends its approval and adoption as
presented.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono
O'odham Nation that it approves the FY 1996 Budget submitted by
the Executive Branch. It is recognized that payroll taxes for the**

Executive Branch employees in the amount of 10% of budgeted salaries are included in the FY 1996 Executive Branch budget. An additional amount equal to 16% of budgeted salaries is budgeted for Employee Benefits for the employees of all three branches of the Tohono O'odham Nation and is made part of the Executive Branch Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$10,078,269.57 are appropriated and authorized to be expended from the sources of funding approved by the Legislative Council for support of the FY 1996 Budgets of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 27TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,457.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 419.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II and Article VI Section 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
