WHEREAS, by Article I, Sections 1 and 2 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, the members of the Nation vested in the government of the Nation the sovereign power, authority and jurisdiction over all lands and activities within the Nation's boundaries; and

such power, authority and jurisdiction accordingly extend to WHEREAS. 12tribal trust, allotted, fee and other lands of any character; and 13 14 under Article IV of the Constitution, the members of the Nation WHEREAS. 15 16 determined that the Nation's government shall consist of the 17 Tohono O'odham Council, office of the Chairman of the Nation 18 19 and the Tohono O'odham Judiciary; and
