

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 1995 Adult Care Group Home Contract Extension**  
**through November 30, 1995)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-497**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Adult Care Group Home Program under FY 1995 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to extend the contract through November 30, 1995 for the specific purpose of completing the renovation of the Adult Care Group Home heating and cooling system; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1996 Adult Care Group Home Contract Extension.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to extend Contract No. 1450CTH54T61068 with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the provision of services titled: Adult Care Group Home Program.**

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4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the duration of this contract extension will  
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6 commence on **October 01, 1995** through **November 30, 1995**.

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8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the  
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10 **Tohono O'Odham Nation** will not fund or operate the program in  
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12 the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no  
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14 executed contract extension has been approved by the Bureau of  
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16 **Indian Affairs**.

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**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the  
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18 **Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials**, to wit: the Chairman and any  
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20 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
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22 the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
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24 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for  
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26 further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
on the 13TH day of OCTOBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 01  
**ABSENT**, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article  
**VI** of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono


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**O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy  
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
