WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Division of
Family Assistance/Child Welfare Services Program under FY 1995
P. L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to extend the contract
through November 30, 1995 for the specific purpose of completing
the renovation of the roofing, heating and cooling system; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
approved the FY 1996 Family Assistance/Child Welfare Services
Contract Extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian
Affairs to extend Contract No. 1450CTH54T61068 with the Tohono
O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for




