RESOLUTION NO. 95-506

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been a member in good standing
since 1944 of the National Congress of American Indians; and**

**WHEREAS, Mary Ann Antone was elected for a two-year term as Treasurer to
the National Congress of American Indians; and**

WHEREAS, the term will expire in October 1995; and

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the re-election of
Mary Ann Antone to the Board of Directors for NCAI.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council hereby supports Mary Ann Antone to be re-elected as the
Treasurer to the National Congress of American Indian.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
16TH. day of OCTOBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
a vote of 1,679.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 91.5 NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [08] ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(1) of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
