

1 **RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**
2 **(Tribal Consultation and Feedback to the Indian Health Design Team Draft**
3 **Recommendations)**

4 **RESOLUTION NO. 95-509**

5 **WHEREAS, a Joint Tribal/Indian Health Service Indian Health Design Team**
6 **was appointed by the Director of Indian Health Service to**
7 **design a new Indian Health Service organizational structure**
8 **that would most effectively meet today's changing realities for**
9 **federal programs; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Indian Health Design Team have issued its draft report**
11 **entitled, "REDESIGN FOR A NEW INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE:**
12 **PRELIMINARY RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE INDIAN HEALTH**
13 **SERVICE DESIGN TEAM" on July 14, 1995; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Indian Health Design Team requested tribal feedback to**
15 **their proposed recommendations by September 1, 1995; and**

16 **WHEREAS, these recommendations will be considered in the final draft of**
17 **the document which the Indian Health Service Director will**
18 **use in addressing the federal downsizing and reductions**
19 **mandated from the Administrations and Congress; and**
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WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation along with the majority of Tribal Governments, given the need to timely respond to the proposed major cuts in the Bureau of Indian Affairs, was not given sufficient time to formally review the recommendations and to provide feedback on the Indian Health Design Team recommendations; and

WHEREAS, only six of the 534 Federally-recognized Tribal Governments have formally responded to the Indian Health Design Team draft recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Design Team has formally stated they would not move forward with the draft recommendations until thorough tribal consultation and feedback was received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Indian Health Service Director not move forward with the proposed Indian Health Design Team

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

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recommendations until tribes are allotted time to thoroughly review the recommendations and formally provide feedback.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 20TH day of OCTOBER 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,315.0 FOR; 0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 561.0(10) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
