

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1996 Law Enforcement and Detention Services/Anti Drug Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 95-514**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Law Enforcement and Detention Services/Anti-Drug Program under FY 1995 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement and Detention Services contract was funded at \$2,356,900 for Fiscal Year 1995; and  
and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement and Detention Service recontract proposed amount for Fiscal Year 1996 is \$2,356,900;  
and**

**WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is reviewing a 19% across-the-board cut in funding for Fiscal Year 1996; and**

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**WHEREAS, the reduction of \$447,811 would mean a reduction in staffing which would mean a reduction in Law Enforcement Services provided to the Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement and Detention Services/Anti-Drug Program requests the National Congress of American Indians for support that no funding cuts be imposed.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we are concerned that the United States is cleaning up the streets in the large cities and municipalities but are neglecting the needs in Indian Country.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 20TH. day of OCTOBER 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,140.0 FOR; 0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and 736.0(11) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




