RESOLUTION NO. 95-522

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is a member in good standing of the
Arizona Indian Gaming Association (AIGA); and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has adopted its Gaming Ordinance and
has entered into a Gaming Compact with the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has derived benefit from its gaming
enterprise and considers the gaming activities of the Nation to be
of benefit to the Nation; and

WHEREAS, Indian Gaming is under constant scrutiny with deliberate attempts
to dissolve gaming enterprises; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation recognizes the positive impact and
benefit of gaming for the Nation; and

WHEREAS, AIGA has developed a public relations plan designed to promote
Indian Gaming throughout the State of Arizona and nationally; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee has reviewed the public relations plan as
developed by the AIGA and recommends that the Legislative
Council support such plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council supports the efforts of the AIGA to promote Indian Gaming throughout the State and nationally.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Nation is hereby designated the Nation's representative to AIGA and the official contact person for communication with AIGA and the media in implementation of the public relations plan.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that funding will be appropriated from the gaming operations.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH day of NOVEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,051.5 FOR; 766.0 AGAINST; 58.5 NOT VOTING; and 02 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
