4 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Legislative Council Resolutions 94-450, 95-152 and
5 95-376, the Nation entered into an Attorney Contract, and
6
7 Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 thereto, with California Indian Legal
8 Services (the "Attorneys") for the purpose of providing legal
9 representation to protect the Nation's interests under the Indian
10 Child Welfare Act in connection with legal proceedings in the State
11 of California; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 1995; and

16 **WHEREAS,** continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's
17 interests in these proceedings; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Attorney General has recommended an extension of the
20 Attorney Contract for fiscal year 1996 in the amount of \$10,000.;

24 **WHEREAS,** the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General for Fiscal
25 Year 1996 has sufficient funds for a Contract in such amount; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the
28 Legislative Council of an Attorney Contract on such terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services in the amount of \$10,000., for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996 and in the form attached hereto.
2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney Contract.
3. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the Fiscal Year 1996 operating budget for the Office of Attorney General.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH. day of NOVEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 06 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
