WHEREAS, the Legislative Council recommended that the proposed budget be tabled until further review by all entities involved (Domestic Affairs Committee, Law Enforcement and Chukut Kuk District, Executive); and

WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Ranger Program FY96 Budget is tabled until meeting is held and that said issue be presented in the January 1996 General Session.


