RESOLUTION NO. 95-545

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the FY 1995 P.L. 93-638 contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to extend the following contracts for provision of services during FY 1996:

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15 1. **The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize**
16 **and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to extend the**
17 **following Contracts with the Tohono O'odham Nation**
18 **under P.L. 93-638 (as amended) regulations and**
19 **procedures for the provision of services.**
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23 2. **The duration of this contract extension will commence on**
24 **October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.**
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27 3. **The Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the**
28 **program in the interim while negotiations are being**

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3 conducted and no executed contract extension has been
4 approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

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6 4. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
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8 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
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10 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract
11 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
12 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
13 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
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16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Secretary of the Interior shall identify
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18 and adequately fund the contracts listed, regardless of the
19 source of such funds, except that such allocation shall not
20 negatively impact other proposals for funds from the Tohono
21 O'odham Nation and presently before the Secretary.
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25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on
26 the 07TH. day of NOVEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was
27 present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and

7 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




