

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing to Continue Law Enforcement Services)**

RESOLUTION NO. 95-548

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's fiscal year for FY95 ended on
September 30, 1995; and**

**WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement program in January of 1995 received
authorization to carry over special appropriation funds in the
amount of \$1,607,627 for FY95; and**

**WHEREAS, Resolution No. 95-459 of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
authorized to continue Law Enforcement services to November 17,
1995; and**

**WHEREAS, it is the Tohono O'odham Nation's desire not to interrupt the
special appropriations funding for the Law Enforcement Program;
and**

**WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Law Enforcement program to carry overall
unexpended FY95 funds into FY96 as several positions remained
unfilled, which left the three proposed substations without buildings
or equipment.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative
Council that it hereby authorizes the Law Enforcement Program to**

7 budget to reflect the use of unexpended FY95 funds as carry over
8 to become part of the overall proposed budget for FY96.

17 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II
18 and Article VI Section 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
19 adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
20 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
21 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
