**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the Tohono
O'odham Psychological Services Day Treatment Program for the
Seriously Mentally Ill through a P.L. Grant; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services recognizes the
need for the seriously and persistently mentally ill, particularly in
the area of psychosocial rehabilitation; and**

**WHEREAS, an important aspect of psychosocial services is a vocational
component: that provides job training, work readiness skills,
personal empowerment and self-esteem and opportunities to earn
an income; and**

**WHEREAS, Desert Survivors Inc. has a significant and extensive history of
providing vocational rehabilitation services for individuals with
disabilities and Desert Survivors operates with a Board of Directors
and would welcome a representative from Tohono O'odham Nation
to serve as a committed member; and**

WHEREAS, Desert Survivors Inc. has prepared and submitted a program statement and description for providing vocational rehabilitation activities which will be incorporated into the existing Day Treatment Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve and support the provisions of vocational rehabilitation services by Desert Survivors Inc. for the consumers of Psychological Services Day Treatment Program and will appoint an individual to serve on the Desert Survivor Board of Directors.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 05TH. day of DECEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II and Article VI Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


