**RESOLUTION NO. 95-564**

**WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Specialist of IHS-OEH&E developed a Solid Waste Management Plan for the Tohono O'odham main reservation; and**

**WHEREAS, in that process, an informal Committee was formed to address solid waste issues and to assist in creating the Solid Waste Management Plan for the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Committee was originally comprised mostly of District Chairpersons and appointed individuals from the nine main Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation with no resolution in place establishing the Committee; and**

**WHEREAS, since its formation, the Solid Waste Management has been meeting on a monthly basis addressing solid waste issues; and**

**WHEREAS, over time, old Solid Waste Committee members have been replaced with new Solid Waste Committee members; and**

**WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation that a resolution be put in place establishing the Solid Waste**


