3 **WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Management Committee and the Environmental

5 Health Specialist of IHS-OEH & E developed a Solid Waste

7 Management Plan for the Tohono O'odham main reservation; and

8 **WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Management Committee presented the Plan to the

10 Legislative Council; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council recommended that the Solid Waste

13 Management Plan along with the Ordinance be presented to the

15 communities and the Districts prior to any proposed resolutions

17 presented to the Legislative body for action; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Operations Department, in behalf of the Solid

20 Waste Management Committee, developed and submitted a solid

22 waste proposal to ITCA for the educational activities within the

25 **WHEREAS,** the Solid Waste Integrated Waste Management Planning Project was

27 funded by EPA through the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and

4 **from ITCA for the Solid Waste Integrated Waste Management**
5 **Planning Project; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Program under the Planning & Operations**
8 **Department would like authorization from the Legislative Council**
9 **to expend these funds.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
13 **that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman**
14 **and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and**
15 **execute the grant agreement.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds identified in the attached budget of**
19 **the Solid Waste Proposal be approved for expenditures accordingly.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the**
22 **06TH. day of DECEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with**
23 **a vote of 1,584.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 292.0 [07] ABSENT,**
24 **pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 3 of Article II and**
25 **Article VI Section 1(b) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by**
27 **the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,**
28 **1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


