Tohono O'odham Nation, by Legislative Resolution #94-393,
established the Tohono O'Odham Department of Human Services;
and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services consists of health, social
service and food distribution programs; and

WHEREAS, the organizational chart of the department includes an Executive
Board for Human Services which shall be known as the Tohono
O'odham Human Service Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Advisory Board will be to provide community
input for policy direction and development for the Department
of Human Service Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Human Service Advisory Board shall be appointed by the
Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation and confirmed by the
Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Human Service Advisory Board shall have eight members, one
from each of the six service areas as designated in the

Department of Human Service Administrative Plan and two at-large members; one with experience in the behavioral health field and one with experience in the social work field; and

WHEREAS, the appointed members will serve four years, staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, the functions of the Advisory Board will be: To provide input regarding community health and social service needs as it relates to Human Services; to review and make recommendations to the Director on proposed new programs, services or policies; to assist in development of long range strategic plans; to assist in establishing priorities for the department; to assist in the research, development and review of new projects/programs; to review and make recommendations to the Director on requests for studies and proposals to be conducted, or requests for publications of work on the Tohono O'Odham Nation that focuses on Human Services; to provide input and to make recommendations on national issues and policy relating to Human

Services; to function as an advocate for the department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive and Legislative Branches have reviewed and approved the establishment of a Human Service Advisory Board, purpose, membership and functions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive and Legislative Branches have reviewed and approved a Human Service per diem rate for six months established in the Management of Health, Indian Health Service Contract, in the amount of \$12,160.00 per diem for travel, training and airfare.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH. day of DECEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,716.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(b) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
