4 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation did  
5  
6 authorize (in Resolution Nos. 95-015, 95-016, and 95-113) the  
7  
8 establishment of a Nursing Home Project Set-Aside Account and  
9  
10 33 consecutive monthly payments of \$450,000., to that account; and

11 **WHEREAS,** this account was established to provide the monies required to  
12  
13 train O'Odham to operate Nursing Home Facility, to plan the  
14  
15 facility, to construct the facility and to initially operate the facility;  
16  
17 and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Nursing Home Project has progressed to the point where it  
19  
20 needs funds to education O'odham and to continue the planning  
21  
22 process; and

23 **WHEREAS,** the Nursing Home Project has submitted the attached FY 1996  
24  
25 Budget explaining the need for \$873,611.00 to fund the  
26  
27 expenditures expected to be incurred by this project during this  
28  
Fiscal Year.

**4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative

**6 Council that this budget for \$873,611.00 be approved.**

**7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Nation's Chairman may enter into all  
**8**  
**9 contracts required to execute the intent of this budget.**

**10 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that since this budget establishes the funds for long  
**11**  
**12 term relationships with institutions of higher education and with**  
**13**  
**14 consultants whose services will be required beyond this Fiscal Year;**  
**15**  
**16 the Nations Chairman is authorized to continue contracting or to**  
**17**  
**18 establish new contracts or to establish other appropriate legal**  
**19**  
**20 instruments (such as Intergovernmental Agreements) as is required**  
**21**  
**22 to fulfill the intent of this budget so long as all expenditures are**  
**23**  
**24 within the intent of and limits of this and any and all future**  
**25 budgets.**

**26 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**  
**27 on the 7TH, day of DECEMBER, 1995 at a meeting at which a quorum was**  
**28 present with a vote of 1,716.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.0**  
**[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of**  
**Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**


