(Supporting the submittal of an Environmental Education Grant to
the EPA by the University of Arizona)

RESOLUTION NO. 95-575

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is committed to the protection of its environment; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports the education of the community and especially the youth in the area of environmental protection; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency announced availability of funds for environmental education proposals; and

WHEREAS, the University of Arizona, in cooperation with staff from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, the Colorado River Indian Tribe, the Hopi Tribe and the Tohono O'Odham Nation, prepared a grant pre-application proposal to submit to the EPA; and

WHEREAS, this grant proposal promotes environmental education for the Tohono O'Odham Nation by providing materials and training to the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the grant proposal will only include the Tohono O'odham Nation if the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council approves its submittal.
