**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL** (Opposition to the reduction of personnel and services at the IHS 1 **Sells Service Unit)**  $\mathbf{2}$ **RESOLUTION NO. 95-591** 3 4 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service (IHS) Sells Service Unit has 5 proposed a FY 1996 Deficit Reduction Plan to reduce the 6 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and other direct provider positions, and pharmacy and medical supplies,  $\mathbf{7}$ and: 8 WHEREAS, a reduction of EMS and other direct health care services 9 and pharmacy and medical supplies will further diminish the level and quality of care to the Tohono O'Odham, and; 10 11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is concerned about the continued health and welfare of its members in regards to 12 the level and adequacy of health services, specifically in 13 regards to response time and transportation for rapid 14 medical care: 15 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation strongly opposes any reduction in regards to EMS staffing 16 and other direct care providers, and pharmacy and medical 17 supplies, and; 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any FY 1996 deficits at the Indian 19 Health Service (IHS) Sells Service Unit, be addressed through Indian Health Service's Redesign/Restructuring  $\mathbf{20}$ savings at the National Headquarters and Area Office, and;  $\mathbf{21}$ 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any additional monies be restored to the FY96 Budget and that those additions be applied to 23 the local level to address services and any deficits; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be sent to the Indian  $\mathbf{25}$ Health Service (IHS) and the Congressional Delegates, 26 and:  $\mathbf{27}$  $\mathbf{28}$
