**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the  
Division of Alcoholism/Substance Abuse - Rehabilitation  
Aftercare Program for Adolescents Component under FY  
1996 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Public Health, Indian  
Health Services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed  
and approved the FY 1996 Indirect Cost Rate of 17%.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
Legislative Council does authorize and request the Public  
Health, Indian Health Service to contract with the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 as amended for  
provision of services titled: Division of  
Alcoholism/Substance Abuse - Rehabilitation Aftercare  
Program for Adolescents Component.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this renewal shall  
commence on October 1, 1995 through September 30,  
1996.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or  
operate the program in the interim while negotiations still**

20 which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; 0 AGAINST;  
21 0 NOT VOTING; and 2 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
22 Council by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
23 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January  
24 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
26 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
