WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the education and training of
O'odham in the area of wildlife conservation; and

WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Plant and Wildlife Committee has created
a proposal to determine the present status of, and a sound
management strategy for the Desert Tortoise in Baboquivari District
lands; and

WHEREAS, the Lannan Foundation is a private foundation which provides
grants for projects such as this one; and

WHEREAS, if this proposal is funded by the Lannan Foundation, it shall be
submitted for final review and approval from Baboquivari District
and the Nation.
