5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is the governing body of the Tohono**
6 **O'odham Nation; and**

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8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has always viewed the health care of the**
9 **children of the Nation as a priority of the Nation; and**

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11 **WHEREAS, the early onset of Type II Diabetes represents a major health**
12 **concern of the Nation for its children; and**

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14 **WHEREAS, the Nation is currently in the third and final year of participating**
15 **in the Pathways feasibility project of which a third grade**
16 **curriculum was developed on Exercise and Nutrition is currently**
17 **being implemented; and**

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20 **WHEREAS, the National Heart/Lung and Blood Institute of the National**
21 **Institute of Health has offered to continue to include the Nation in**
22 **a cooperative program to continue to examine ways to prevent**
23 **early onset of Type II diabetes and prevention of obesity in Native**
24 **American Children through the Pathways Project; and**

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5 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council is willing to cooperate with Gila River Indian
6 Community and the University of Arizona in the exploration of
7 appropriate measures for obesity prevention; and

8 **WHEREAS,** this Pathways project has the potential to benefit all the school age
9 children on the Nation.

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BEFORE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
11 Council approves and endorses the Nation's participation in the
12 Obesity prevention project proposed by the National Heart/Lung
13 and Blood Institute.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
15 12TH. day of JANUARY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
16 a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT,
17 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(f) of the
18 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
19 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
20 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
21 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
