**RESOLUTION NO. 96-028**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department has brought forth a**  
**budget modification #1 to its 1995/1996 tribal budget; and**

**WHEREAS, the budget modification moves savings from its Salaries, Fringe**  
**Benefits, and Repair & Maintenance - Equipment line items and**  
**applies them towards a new line item for Office Equipment; and**

**WHEREAS, the new line item will provide for the purchase of a copier,**  
**printers, and computer software which were not included in our**  
**1995/1996 Capital Equipment budget due to unforeseen needs.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BEFORE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
**Council that it does support, recognize and authorize the Tohono**  
**O'odham Education Department's request for the addition of a new**  
**line item for office equipment.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**  
**approves the Tohono O'odham Education Department's Budget**  
**Modification #1.**




