(Override vetoed Resolution No. 96-019, Appropriating \$46,488 from the
Capital Equipment to enhance the 911 Emergency System)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-033

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve Resolution No. 96-019 (Appropriate \$46,488 from the Capital Equipment to enhance the 911 Emergency System) during the January 10, 1996 General Session; and

WHEREAS, upon presentation of Resolution No. 96-019 to the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, he did disapprove thereof and returned it to the Council with his objections in accordance with the provisions of Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, during the February 5, 1996 Legislative Session, the Chairman of the Nation presented his justifications in vetoing Resolution No. 96-019; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the Chairman's objections and after consideration again voted to pass Resolution No. 96-019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby override the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 96-019 by a vote of two-thirds of the votes cast.

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The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH. day of FEBRUARY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,173.0 FOR; 494.0 AGAINST; 209.0 NOT VOTING ; and 02 ABSENT, was passed by majority of at least **TWO-THIRDS (2/3)** [1,111.5] of the votes cast as required by Section V of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
