8 **the management and development of Indian Agriculture resources;**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Agriculture and Water**  
12  
13 **Resources Committees, Districts, and other entities of the Tohono**  
14  
15 **O'odham Nation have actively participated in the Southwest Indian**  
16  
17 **Agriculture Association; and**

18 **WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to maintain**  
19  
20 **membership in the Southwest Indian Agriculture Association; and**

21 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Nation membership dues in the amount of**  
22  
23 **\$200.00 for Calendar Year 1996 are due and payable.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby**

26 **supports continued participation to the Southwest Indian**

28 **Agriculture Association and authorizes payment of annual**  
**membership dues in the amount of \$200.00.**

pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(d)(2) of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16  
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
