**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation realizes the need to protect valuable**  
**ancestral remains and cultural resources; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Historical Preservation Fund**  
**recognize both the need and the opportunity to develop a**  
**permanent facility for recognizing and promoting the Nation's**  
**cultural and historical resources; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Historical Preservation Fund**  
**understand that in order to insure the culturally sensitive**  
**preservation and display of these ancestral remains there is an**  
**urgent need to train Tohono O'odham in cultural resources**  
**management; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Historical Preservation Fund**  
**fully understand such training will promote cultural**  
**renewal/cultural revitalization while instilling a sense of pride**  
**among all O'odham of their historical and cultural contributions to**

**WHEREAS, the Historical Preservation Fund has written a proposal to the U.S. Department of the Interior for funding in the amount of \$49,951.98 for the purposes of planning these cultural preservation programs and request approval from the Legislative Council to continue pursuing this unique funding opportunity.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that it approves the submission of a proposal by the Historical Preservation Fund to the Department of the Interior for funds totaling \$49,951.98 for training O'odham in cultural resources management and the planning of a Nation's museum.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 9TH, day of FEBRUARY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(d)(2) & (c)(8) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
