LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 96-064

WHEREAS, on Friday, February 09, 1996 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council reviewed their agenda established for the day; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council amended the agenda per Legislative Order 96-057 to include the issue on travel policy; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has stated that there is no travel policy in place and the committee has met with the Chairman of the Nation, Legislative Officers and the Judicial Branch to discuss a overall travel policy for the Nation; and

WHEREAS, upon further discussion, there were questions and concerns regarding the balance of remaining funds given for airfare, lodging and meals which was not clearly stated in approval of resolution 96-063 (Approval of Tohono O'odham Nation Travel Policy); and

WHEREAS, a motion was made to have the rules committee develop an internal policy for the Legislative Branch and to address the concerns as mentioned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby directs the Rules Committee to develop an internal travel policy within 30 working days for the Tohono O'odham Legislative Branch.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED the policy would address concerns regarding the airfare, lodging, meals and monies remaining from perdiem.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 09TH day of February, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 980.0 FOR; 709.0 AGAINST; 187.0 NOT VOTING; and (5) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
